Perform iron curls, hair designs, roller sets, scalp treatments, shampoos and conditions.

Perform sculpted curls, finger waves and blow dries.

Perform haircuts along with sectioning.
Explain scissor and razor shaping, along with clipper cutting.
Explain quick service hair styling and use of implements.
Describe finger waves, rollers and sculptured curls.
Describe the six facial shapes and three profiles.
Identify base directed hair, hair-styling terms, facial features and hairstyling considerations.
Apply four and five styling sections.
Apply finger wave and roller comb outs.
List haircutting safety precautions.
Define three sculptured curl strengths.
Define roller material and placement.
Perform clipper cut, scissor shaping, razor shaping and beard mustache trims.
Perform hairstyling and selection of a hair style.
