*Five of these areas are optional and up to the applicant to complete. These include: the general education requirements, OT observation hours, related work experience, volunteer work experience, and prior completion of a post-secondary degree.*

*To be best informed and prepared for the OTA program, faculty do encourage completion of any or all general education requirements and OT observation hours.*
