

# EARN YOUR SOLAR PHOTOVOLTAIC TECHNICIAN CERTIFICATE BY JUNE 6, 2023

OPEN TO ALL ELECTRICAL STUDENTS IN THE MINNESOTA STATE SYSTEM

To address the rapid growth and the need for solar installers, Minnesota West Community & Technical College is offering the Solar Photovoltaic Technician Certificate through a unique schedule at the Canby, MN campus. This will include 6 lecture credits (89 hours online, 7 hours in-person) and 4 lab credits (128 hours in-person). This program will start with the online component March 13, 2023 and will finish with the lab component on June 6, 2023. The courses are listed below.
