

# Spring 2020 Student Survey Cumulative Report

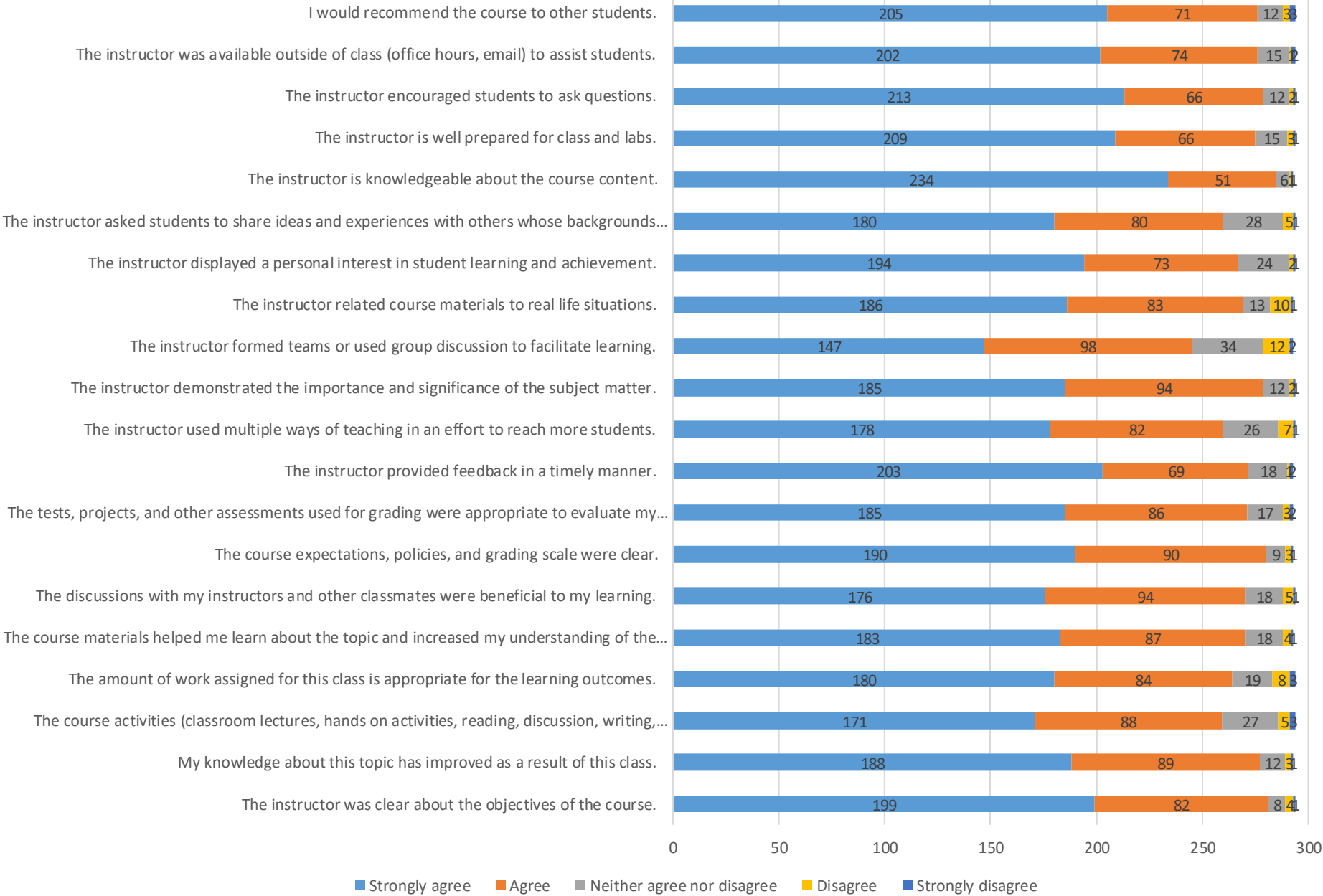
The following data encompasses surveys completed for faculty during the Spring 2020 semester. Faculty who were on the evaluation cycle were included in this survey. Faculty could also opt in and ask for surveys to be set up for other classes. These were not used as part of the evaluation cycle for those faculty. Approximately 300 students provided survey feedback.

All identifying information has been removed from this report. The reports shared with faculty and deans had the specific information that has been removed in this report.
