# Spring 2020 Concurrent Enrollment Survey Results, Minnesota West Community and Technical College

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# **Overview**

Minnesota West Community and Technical College offers REACH/concurrent classes to 18 area high schools. Spring or yearlong courses were offered at 17 schools, and student feedback was collected from at least 1 course at 15 schools via SurveyMonkey. As part of our assessment and evaluation efforts, course evaluations are provided for each course section offered through this program. For Spring 2019, 88% of the courses had surveys returned, with 450 students providing commentary on the courses and instruction. This is a significant decrease in the number of students providing feedback, and likely due to the COVID-19 pandemic (instructors are typically encouraged to allow class time for students to complete the survey).

The raw survey data is supplied in Appendix A and student comments are provided in Appendix B.

# **Compilation and Review of Survey Data**

The REACH students were asked the following five questions regarding the courses:

- Question 1: My understanding of the subject matter has improved as a result of this class.
- Question 2: The reading, discussion, writing, projects, papers, and other course activities have helped me learn more about the subject matter.
- Question 3: The assignments in this course have helped me learn more about the subject matter.
- Question 4: The course materials were helpful in understanding the subject matter.
- Question 5: The assessments (quizzes, tests, projects, papers) were effective and provided me with feedback on my progress in mastering the subject.
- Question 6: Are there enough labs/activities to support the content in the class?

The high school instructors distribute the SurveyMonkey link to students, and the results are collected and reviewed by Minnesota West staff. This summary data report is also provided to high school instructors, counselors, and administrators, as well as college mentor faculty and administration.

Individual evaluation reports are provided to high school instructors and their mentors (these have been distributed). High school faculty and college mentors review the comments and make appropriate modifications. While not all students are able to effectively evaluate course activities, instructors look for patterns and themes in the comments and make modifications in those areas.

# Question 1: My understanding of the subject matter has improved as a result of this class.

Overall, students across all schools agreed with this statement; 408 students out of 449 (91%) agreed or strongly agreed with this statement.

# Question 2: The reading, discussion, writing, projects, papers, and other course activities have helped me learn more about the subject matter.

Students also agreed that the course activities assisted them in their learning; 394 out of 450 (87.5%) agreed or strongly agreed with this statement.

# Question 3: The assignments in this course have helped me learn more about the subject matter.

Students also agreed that the course activities assisted them in their learning; 390 out of 449 (87%) agreed or strongly agreed that the assignments did help in their learning.

# Question 4: The course materials were helpful in understanding the subject matter.

A slight increase from last spring, 85% (386 of 449) of students agreed or strongly agreed that the course materials did help in their learning.

# Question 5: The assessments (quizzes, tests, projects, papers) were effective and provided me with feedback on my progress in mastering the subject.

In a 4-point increase from last spring, 85% (382 of 450) agreed or strongly agreed that the assignments did help in their learning. About 11% of the students were neutral, and about 4% disagreed or strongly disagreed with this statement.

# Question 6: Are there enough labs/activities to support the content in the class?

This question was added to the survey this year per instructor suggestion. Over 96% (433 of 450) of respondents stated there were. Students also had the opportunity to respond to an open-ended follow-up question: If no, which areas would you like covered, or what activities would you suggest?

Of the 15 replying "no," 10 provided additional feedback. Much of this feedback was generic (statements such as "more labs") or repeated in the responses to the open-ended questions listed in Appendix B. This question will be removed from the survey for the upcoming school year.
