

Minnesota West Community & Technical College Short Term Loan Application

The Minnesota West Short Term Loan Fund is designed to temporarily assist students with unexpected expenses caused by unforeseen family, medical, or personal circumstances. The maximum amount available is \$400.00 (minimum \$100.00) and only one loan may be outstanding at any given time during the semester. Students must have adequate financial aid available in order to qualify. It is expected that all amounts owed Minnesota West including short term loans be paid prior to enrollment in future terms. Students who are currently past due on payments to Minnesota West will not be eligible for a short term loan.
